



*Cut-off for* קדושת פירות שביעית

A cut-off point to determine whether a product has *k'dushat shvi'it* whose growth spans a two *Shmittah* years is determined by time the product has grown to the stage after which one must separate *trumot* and *ma'asrot*. If this "cut-off" point occurs during the *Shmittah* year, the product has *k'dushat shvi'it*.

ירק Vegetables	לקיטה When it is picked
אילן Tree	חנטה Blossoming
אורז, דוחן, פרגין, שומשין (ועוד) Rice, millet, poppy and sesame (2:7) [Produce that don't grow at the same time.]	השרשה Takes root.
